1.0 Overview

The WESM Penalty Manual provides for post-investigation remedies of the trading participants relative to the enforcement of the rules in WESM, namely, the filing of the Request for Reconsideration and Appeal based on grounds specified in Section 4.12 of the said Manual.

Please note that this Compliance Bulletin covers the guidelines pertinent to the available remedy of a Trading Participant under the above-stated Penalty Manual, in relation to a decision or action of the Enforcement and Compliance Office under Sections 5.2.2 and 5.2.3 of the Enforcement and Compliance Manual, as follows:

- 1) Reliefs connected to the enforcement action imposed after the **regular compliance monitoring and assessment (CMA) activity**¹ of the Enforcement and Compliance Office (ECO).
- 2) Proceeding or remedy provided under the Penalty Manual if the action emanates from **investigation**² following a request for investigation (RFI) endorsed by the PEMC Board of Directors to ECO or initiated by ECO (*motu proprio*).
